

NOT AS EASY AS ABC

Place letters A–D in each row and column of the grid exactly once. There is always one cell that remains empty in every row and column.

The letters and numbers on the outside indicate the position where the letter should be placed when looking from that side.

For example, D3 clue means that letter D is the third letter encountered in the row or column when looking from that side. The letter D may not necessarily be in the third cell, it is simply the third letter in that row or column.
