

KAKURO

Kakuro is the mathematical equivalent of crossword. The number in the top right of a black cell relates to an "across" clue and the number in the bottom left is the "down" clue.

Fill digits 1-9 in the white cells to total the clue associated with them. However no digit can be duplicated in an entry. For example, for a sum clue of 4 in two white cells, digits 1 and 3 are possible, but not 2 and 2.
