
STOSTONE

Shade some cells of the grid black (a shaded area is a "stone") such that all black cells in a region (indicated by thick black lines) are connected horizontally or vertically.

A numbered cell indicates how many cells in the region must be shaded black. In regions without a number, any amount of cells may be black (at least one). When two cells are orthogonally adjacent across a region boundary, at least one cell must be white.

Importantly, if all stones "fall down", they must cover the bottom half of the grid exactly without any gaps.
