
KAPAMA

The goal is to shade some cells black to make pairs of figures (twin shapes).

Twin shapes are symmetrical with respect to a diagonal line and connected through this diagonal line. No two shapes may share an edge. Cells with diagonal lines can not be shaded black.

Numbers outside the grid show the number of black cells in the corresponding row or column.





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
