
TOICHIKA

Place arrows in some empty cells such that each region (indicated by thick black lines) contains exactly one arrow. The task is to create pairs of arrows that point at each other. The puzzle is solved when there are no unpaired arrows left.

The two regions with paired arrows must not be horizontally or vertically adjacent, that is, they should not share an edge. There should not be any other arrow placed in between two paired arrows.
