

SHIMAGUNI

Shade some cells of the grid black such that all black cells in a region (indicated by thick black lines) are always orthogonally connected.

A cell with a number indicates how many cells in that region should be shaded. In regions without a number, any amount of cells may be black (at least one).

Two regions with the same number of black cells must not be orthogonally adjacent. When two cells are orthogonally adjacent across a region boundary, at least one cell must be white.
