

YAJISAN-KAZUSAN

Shade some cells black such that all the unshaded cells form an orthogonally continuous area. The black cells must not be orthogonally connected.

A cell containing a number and an arrow represents how many black cells are in the row or column pointed at by the arrow. Numbered cells must be shaded black if they contain false clues, but numbered cells painted black do not necessarily contain false clues.
