

KAKURO

Kakuro is the mathematical equivalent of crossword. The number in the top right of a black cell relates to an "across" clue and the number in the bottom left is the "down" clue.

Fill digits 1–9 in the white cells to total the clue associated with them. However no digit can be duplicated in an entry. For example, for a sum clue of 4 in two white cells, digits 1 and 3 are possible, but not 2 and 2.
