

## MATHRAX

Fill numbers 1–7 in the grid such that no number repeats in any row or column. Additional conditions given in circles need to be satisfied by the four intersecting cells.

A number and a sign (+, −, ×, ÷) means that the circled number is a result of an operation using numbers in diagonally adjacent cells (top left and bottom right; top right and bottom left). The letters "E" ("even") and "O" ("odd") mean that all numbers in the four cells are even and odd, respectively.
