

KUROMASU

Each given number in the grid represents the number of white cells that can be seen from that cell, including itself. A cell can be seen from another cell if they are in the same row or column, and there are no black cells between them in that row or column.

The numbered cells cannot be black. No two black cells may be horizontally or vertically adjacent. All the white cells must be connected orthogonally.
