

USOWAN

Shade some cells in the grid black such that no two black cells are vertically or horizontally adjacent and all white cells are connected in the solved puzzle.

The numbered cells in the grid (these are always white) indicate the number of black cells that must be placed adjacent to their four sides. There is one (and only one) liar numbered cell clue in each irregular region, which means that this clue shows the wrong number of black cells adjacent to it.
