

SASHIKAZUNE

Divide the grid into L-shaped regions; the two 'legs' of the L-region must be exactly one cell wide. There cannot be more than three numbered cells in a region, and there may be regions in the grid that do not have any numbers.

A given number indicates how many cells there are up to that cell where the L-region bends (including the numbered cell itself). Thus, a cell with number 1 is where the L-region bends.
