

ILLUSTRATION

The task is to shade some cells black.

A number in a white (black) cell represents the number of empty white (black) cells that can be seen from that cell (excluding itself from the count) until it encounters a black (white) cell or another numbered cell or the edge of the grid.

Note: A cell can be seen by another cell if they are in the same row or column. The color of numbered cells cannot be changed.
