## TATAMIBARI

The puzzle grid has three kinds of symbols: cross, horizontal bar, vertical bar. Divide the grid into rectangular regions such that each region contains one cell with a symbol.

A region with a cross must be a square. If a region contains a horizontal bar, the region's width must be greater than its height. If a region contains a vertical bar, the region's width must be less than its height.

A grid dot must not be shared by the corners of four regions.
