## WATARIDORI

Connect the circles in pairs by drawing horizontal and vertical lines that pass through the centers of the cells. A line can visit a cell only once and may connect circles with equal numbers, empty circles, or an empty circle with a numbered circle.

A number in a circle indicates how many bold-outlined regions are visited by the connecting line. A line can pass through a region only once. Note that there may be some empty cells in the solved puzzle, that is, no connecting line passes through them.


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
