GAPS

Shade some cells of the grid black such that each row and each column contains two black cells. A black cell cannot touch another black cell, not even diagonally.

The numbers outside the grid are the number of white cells between the black cells in the corresponding row or column.

Tip: Start by identifying cells that cannot be black.
