

ISLAND

The puzzle grid has numbers in some cells. The aim is to shade some cells of the grid black such that all the white cells form a single island. Each numbered cell must be a part of this island.

The numbers indicate how many unnumbered white cells can be reached from that cell by moving horizontally or vertically. Numbered cells (and shaded cells) block access to the white cells.
