Some black circles and cells in the puzzle grid have numbers or question marks. Divide the grid into rectangular regions such that each region contains exactly one number or question mark.

A number indicates how many black circles are in its region. The region with a question mark may contain any amount of black circles (at least one).

Orthogonally adjacent circles must belong to the same region.
